## ELECTRONIC VOTER INFORMATION WEBSITE

As directed in Utah Code section 20A-7-801, Utah's lieutenant governor hosts a statewide electronic voter information website. Candidates may submit statements of qualifications (up to 200 words) and certain biographical information for inclusion on the website.

You can create an online profile page that will provide information about you to the voters at: <http://vote.utah.gov/create-candidate-profile/>.

You will need to use the following Entry Code to begin the process: **Vote2012**.

Once you submit your profile an email will be sent to our office notifying us that your profile is complete. We will then review and approve your profile page and link it to your name on the "Sample Ballot" found at [vote.utah.gov](http://vote.utah.gov). No candidate profiles will appear on the website until after the submission deadline.

For **Primary Election** candidates the deadline to complete this is **5:00 p.m., Monday, May 14, 2012**. We will not accept any new submissions or changes to your profile after that time.

For **General Election** candidates the deadline to complete this is **5:00 p.m., Friday, September 7, 2012**. We will not accept any new submissions or changes to your profile after that time.
